LOCATION

Situated in the heart of Leith, Edinburgh's fashionable waterfront, Fingal is a 2-minute walk away from the 'Port of Leith' tram stop and close by a selection of award-winning restaurants, artisan shops and galleries.

A short distance away is The Royal Yacht Britannia, which was a home away from home for Queen Elizabeth II for over 40 years. Visitors can follow in the footsteps of Royalty to discover the heart and soul of this most special of Royal residences.

BALLROOM

Fingal's elegant Ballroom, with capacity to host up to 60 guests for dinner, is perfect for exclusive events. A spectacular space reached by two sweeping staircases and nestled in the former hold of the ship. The Ballroom features the raised Gallery Bar for music and entertainment, plus a moveable skylight.

ACCOMODATION

Fingal's 23 luxury cabins are each named after Stevenson lighthouses, inspired by her rich maritime heritage. Sleek corridors lined with lighthouse images lead to the choice of cabins. Luxury Cabins with access to the deck, Duplex cabins with comfortable living space or the stunning Skerryvore Suite with extensive outdoor space to relax and entertain. Sumptuous heritage fabrics created by Scottish textile designer Araminta Campbell, luxury Noble Isle amenities and bespoke embroidered headboards



THE LIGHTHOUSE RESTAURANT

This space offers a stylish, yet relaxed setting for enjoying Fingal's interpretation of a classic afternoon tea or dinner, celebrating the best of Scotland's larder, from coast to port. Sip a chilled glass of Champagne or a signature Lighthouse Martini from our creative cocktail menu, whilst the sun sets through the floor-to-ceiling glass windows. Spacious outdoor decks provide a blend of private and public spaces to bask in the quayside setting or sit out under the stars.

THE BRIDGE

The Bridge, home to the ship's original wheel, sits on our top deck. Once the vessel's nerve centre, it now offers a beautiful setting for private dining for up to 10 guests, meetings, and intimate weddings. With waterfront views, plush seating, and exquisite tableware, it's the ideal space to relax and dine in style.

The Bridge also hosts our Chef's Table - a five-course interactive tasting menu for 6-10 guests, where the kitchen becomes the stage and every dish tells a story.
