Fully Compostable Coffee Pods

- Fingal is proud to be using fully compostable coffee pods. Approximately 29,000 single-use coffee pods are discarded into landfills every minute, generating over 120,000 tonnes of waste annually.

Used Soap Donation

- We are now donating our used soap bars to the Vine Trust, the ship located adjacent to Fingal. The Vine Trust are using the soap to support their projects in Africa.
